Veeva Network 20R1.0.2 Patch Release Notes

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Updates in this release

This patch resolves the following issues:

Issues were occurring when report queries contained fields with Boolean values.

Source subscriptions displayed a "Server having problems" error.

The data quality test case called `Address - Invalid / Deleted / Merged Into Address with Active Custom Key` failed to run.

In some cases, data stewards were unable to approve data change requests.

Addresses in Puerto Rico could not be verified when Puerto Rico is the state/province and United States is the country.

A reporting column limit was causing an "Unknown error. Target lists can have at most 1664 entries" error when running a query in the SQL Query Editor.

Data deduplication jobs that contained filters with Boolean values displayed null pointer exceptions.
