Updates in this release

PATCH NOTE UPDATE

The following fix has been removed from this maintenance release:

• Under certain conditions, merging addresses triggered the recalculation of primary address and/or primary affiliation flags. This occurred because of a defect in the Address Merge capability that was released in Network version 20R2 (August 2020).

The issue affected addresses and affiliations that used the Network Calculated or Unique Checkbox primary field configurations.

The fix will be available in a later release.

RESOLVED ISSUES

This patch resolves the following issues:

- Duplicate custom keys on custom objects and sub-objects in source feeds may cause key alignment issues in the Network UI and Reporting.
- Some scheduled data quality reports do not complete because of resource issues in the data warehouse.
